A very low prevalence HIV epidemic. Absence of surveillance data, monitoring of epidemic based on mandatory screening programmes and case-finding. Lack of community-based prevalence surveys among KP means that some pockets of infection may be undetected and full scope of epidemic is unknown. No prevalence surveys undertaken among Sex Workers (SW), Men having Sex with Men (MSMs) and Persons Injecting Drugs (PIDs). Data either is inexistent or outdated.

Percentage of women/men who report discriminatory attitudes towards people living with HIV


