The prevalence among the general population (15-49 years, 2019) is less than 0.1%, with some evidence of concentrated epidemics among Men having Sex with Men (MSMs) and Persons Injecting Drugs (PIDs). The data evidence is considered outdated. In-depth HIV/STIs knowledge on modes of transmission and prevention remains relatively mediocre among young people. Sexual risk behaviors are observed in relatively worrying rates across different groups of young people including low condom among key populations Sex Workers (SW), MSMs and PIDs. Education policies guiding delivery of Life Skills based HIV and sexuality education, according to international standards, do not exist neither in Primary school nor in Secondary School, nor in teacher training. Laws do not require parental consent for adolescents younger than 18 years to access Sexual Reproductive Health, though it is required for HIV testing and HIV treatment; contraceptives including condoms. The youth are included in the consultation process during the development of HIV National Strategic Plan 2018-2022, currently NAP in collaboration with UNAIDS and WHO is working to update this NSP to cover the period till 2025, this update will be discussed with all stakeholders including Youth. However, they participate in Civil Society coordination spaces of populations most affected by HIV, community advisory body for hospitals, clinics and/or research projects.



Percentage of women/men who report discriminatory attitudes towards people living with HIV




### 20-24 years
