The prevalence among the general population (15-49 years, 2019) is less than 0.1%. In-depth HIV/STIs knowledge on modes of transmission and prevention remains very low among young people. Education policies guiding delivery of Life Skills based HIV and sexuality education, according to international standards, exist only in secondary school (fully implemented by 51-75%) and no teacher training. Laws requiring parental consent for adolescents younger than 12 years to access HIV testing. Young people do not participate in policy/guidelines/strategy development related to their health nor in the national HIV response. Data remains scarce, or not accessible.


