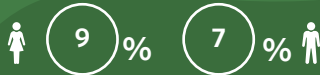

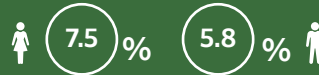

No information on the prevalence neither the nature of the epidemic is available. Education policies that guide the delivery of life skills based HIV and sexuality education, according to international standards do not exist neither in primary nor secondary school, nor teacher training. Laws do not require parental consent for adolescents younger than 18 years to access HIV testing. HIV treatment. Young people do not participate in policy/guidelines/strategy development related to their health nor in decision-making spaces in the national HIV response. Data remains scarce and inaccessible.

- Adolescent girls/boys (15-19 years) (2019)



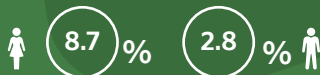

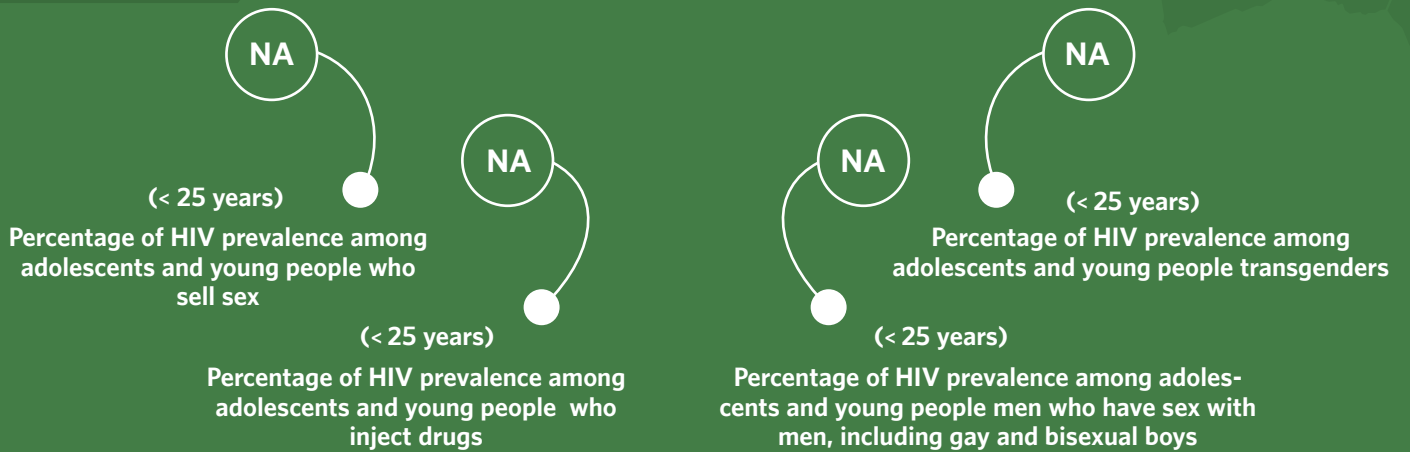
