with essential reproductive health care since January 2014



1.1 million women catered for

with 1,763 reproductive health kits (supplies and equipment)



63,308 childbirths assisted



59,029 clean delivery kits

supplied to pregnant women



41,500 dignity kits

distributed to women and girls, with clothes and hygiene supplies



563,000 people can be treated

by the 158 health care providers trained in two years



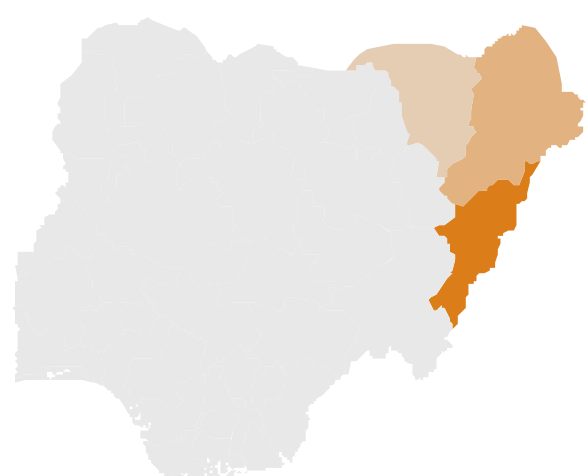
