III. Content of quotations

Quotations should be submitted in a single email whenever possible, depending on file size. Quotations must contain:

a) Price quotation, to be submitted strictly in accordance with the price quotation form.

All parts of the quotation must be signed by the bidding company's relevant authority and submitted in PDF format.

Proposals should be prepared based on the guidelines set forth in Section III above, along with a properly filled out and signed price quotation form, and are to be sent by email to the contact person indicated below no later than **19 October 2022, at 4pm Cairo time.**

- The following reference must be included in the email subject line UNFPA/ASRO/RFQ/22/010 to organize Annual Regional Communications Workshop 20-22 November in Cairo/Egypt. Offers that do not contain the correct email subject line may be overlooked by the procurement officer and therefore not considered.
- The total email size may not exceed 20 MB (including email body, encoded attachments and headers). Where the technical details are in large electronic files, it is recommended that these be sent separately before the deadline.
- Any quotation submitted will be regarded as an offer by the bidder and does not constitute or imply the acceptance of any quotation by UNFPA. UNFPA is under no obligation to award a contract to any bidder as a result of this RFQ.

IV. Overview of Evaluation Process

Quotations will be evaluated based on the compliance with the technical specifications and the total cost of the goods (price quote).

The evaluation will be carried out in a two-step process by an ad-hoc evaluation panel. Technical proposals will be evaluated for technical compliance prior to the comparison of price quotes.

V. Award Criteria

In case of a satisfactory result from the evaluation process, UNFPA intends to award a Purchase Order (PO) to the Bidder(s) that obtain the highest total score.



VI. Right to Vary Requirements at Time of Award

UNFPA reserves the right at the time of award of contract to increase or decrease by up to 20% the volume of services specified in this RFQ without any change in unit prices or other terms and conditions.

VII. Payment Terms

UNFPA payment terms are net 30 days upon receipt of invoice and delivery/acceptance of the milestone deliverables linked to payment as specified in the contract.

VIII. Fraud and Corruption

UNFPA is committed to preventing, identifying, and addressing all acts of fraud against UNFPA, as well as against third parties involved in UNFPA activities.
